Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The school has had 3 successful weeks to start the term off. With a range of lessons and programs running in classes, and students receiving excellent support from the teaching staff and the SSOs. A special Thank You to Trevor Broughton, who has been actively engaging the year 6/7 class in a range of activities, while filling in for Mr Hanna.

Last night, I had the pleasure of watching the Riverland Primary Schools Music Performance at the Chaffey Theatre. Congratulations to the 24 choir students for their commitment and effort to learn all of the songs to ensure that the concert was such a success. This year we had many students taking on important roles throughout the performance. Well done Kasey and Chelsea for being the comperes and congratulations to Jack, Angelina, Alannah and Melissa for your soloist roles. Our Cobdogla Primary Students represented the school with such pride and they even made the front page of the Murray Pioneer. A huge thank you to Michelle Drogemuller for her enthusiasm and effort for training our choir students throughout the year and taking on the role of Cluster B secretary, program coordinator and production committee.

On Thursday, the year 7 students had a visit from Glossop High School staff, to provide enrolment packs and information about their transition program. In weeks 5 and 6, the year 7s will take part in two interaction/open days at Glossop High School Middle Campus.

Thank You to all the Parents/Carers that have returned their School Survey to the front office. So far we have received 27 surveys, which is pleasing. The purpose of the survey is to provide the school and Governing Council with feedback on how it is progressing and to see our strengths or areas to improve. So far the result of the survey is very positive. Please remember that you are always welcome to make an appointment with your classroom teacher or myself, if you have any concerns/feedback.

Three way Interviews are planned for week 7, and you will receive a letter home shortly with further information.

Over the last few weeks the students have participated in an Evacuation and Invacuation drill. I have been impressed with the students and staff, as they have remained calm and followed the Emergency Management Procedure. For an Evacuation children and staff assemble onto the school oval with the bell ringing in short blasts. Also, circumstances could arise whereby it would be safer for students and staff to remain indoors, this is called an Invacuation. In this case there is a continuous blast of the siren with no pauses, and students are expected to calmly remain in their classroom, or if outside move to the nearest classroom/building.

This Friday, 23 students from Cobdogla Primary School are taking part in the Riverland SAPSASA Athletics Carnival. There are a number of Parents/Carers that are taking children to the event or have indicated that they are able to help, your support is much appreciated.

Finally, a reminder that Friday 17th of August is a STUDENT FREE DAY, with staff attending a Corwin Visible Learning Day with our partnership group at the Berri Hotel.



Gluten, Dairy & Sugar Free Lunch Box Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 tsp chia seeds
- 80 g coconut oil
- 155 g rapadura sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 150 g gluten-free all-purpose flour mix
- 1/2 tsp baking powder
- 1/4 tsp bicarbonate of soda
- 60 g vegan milk chocolate
- 1/4 tsp sea salt



Method

In a small bowl, thoroughly mix the chia seeds and 20ml water. Set aside to become gelatinous.

In a bowl, beat the coconut oil and sugar with an electric mixer for 3–4 minutes until creamy. Add the chia mixture and vanilla and beat until well combined.

In a large bowl, sift flour, baking powder and bicarbonate of soda. Add the wet ingredients and mix with a spatula until combined. Gently fold through the chocolate chunks and sea salt. Refrigerate the dough for 20 minutes. Preheat the oven to 180°C (160°C fan forced). Line two 38 cm x 25 cm baking trays (cookie sheets) with baking paper. Using wet hands, scoop a tablespoon of the mixture, roll it into a ball and place on the baking tray. Repeat with the remaining mixture. Be sure to leave plenty of room between each cookie as the dough will spread!
Bake for 10–12 minutes. Remove from the oven and cool on a wire rack before eating.
